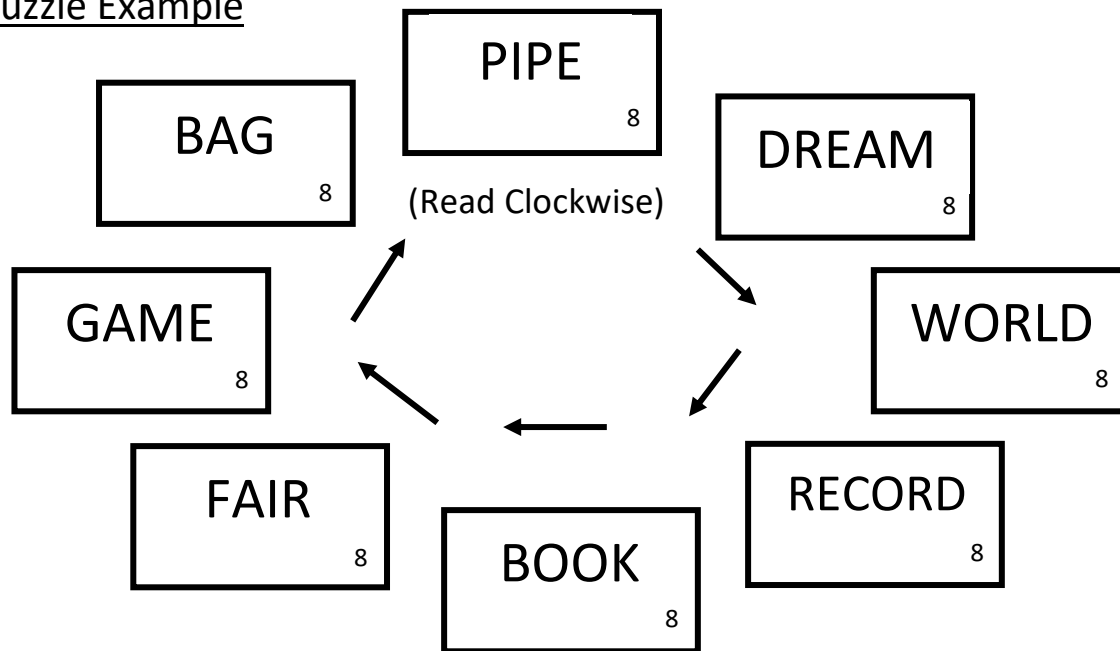


Word Circle Puzzles Challenge

Puzzle Example



- Your Word Circle Puzzles kit contains sets of word cards.
- **Sets are determined by the number in the bottom right corner of each Word Card.** Start with the puzzle that has the lowest number. For example, if it's an "8" card puzzle (like the one above), make sure you have all "8" word cards. (If there is any, ignore the extra writing in the bottom right corner.)
- All word cards of one puzzle set must be held in the hands of the players in your group until the solution is found.
- Each person in the group must always have at least one card in their possession at all times - unless there are less cards than people.
- **Your group can ask a facilitator two questions about each puzzle.** For example: What word goes before (word)? What word goes after (word)? NOTE: The facilitator can choose not to answer your question if it reveals too much information (e.g., What is the answer to this puzzle?)
- **When everyone in your group agrees they have solved the puzzle** - with everyone in your circle holding at least one card - ask your facilitator for the answer card (tell them the number of your puzzle).
- After checking your answer, and celebrating your success (or, maybe not), set this puzzle aside and move on to the next highest number.
- Continue working on the puzzles until your facilitator stops the challenge.
